

LCA Meeting Notes 4/28/22

Lindsey S. lead us in prayer.

Bertha Wenig Mattix introduced herself to the group and said that she was present to volunteer with the group. Welcome Bertha and thank you.

Rhonda read the secretaries' report provided by Cheryl. The following corrections were made:

Bob Tyler instead of "Howell;" The FD Association and the Auxiliary will pay for the cost of security at the Bang; and the FD is asking for donations from LCA toward work-out equipment (not to pay for all of the equipment).

With these changes the report was approved.

Connie was not present to give a treasurer's report. The balance will remain as provided at the last meeting.

Matt reported on the progress of the pop a shot game for the Bang. He said that if a wagon is borrowed for the project, it may need to be modified that may affect the integrity of the wagon itself. For less than \$100 he can get a net and a couple of portable hoops instead of using a wagon. In the future, he suggested that the FFA purchase a designated wagon that could be modified for the game. Cheryl may have some netting for the project. Barb will contact the bb team to see if they can man the game. Rose has a couple free standing hoops at her house.

Barb reported that she rented a duck using the website today. During the meeting Rhonda then signed up for the 5-k using the website.

Pastor Ray Holtz will portray Walter Lingo at the Bang. J. Anderson will also do a historical talk.

Cheryl reported that she heard back from the NFL. The Bengals said no. She asked the Browns for merchandise, and she hasn't heard back from them. The Pro Football Hall of Fame was supposed to call Jim. Jim hasn't heard from them yet.

A Bang meeting was held on April 24th. Diane has the parade "under control." The group discussed efforts to have 100 Airedale dogs in the parade.

Amy discussed that they ordered 1000 can koozies. However, they cannot split the order between designs. The koozies ordered have the IO on one side and 100th Anniversary on the other. Jeff moved for the group to order 250 koozies that have an Airedale dog on one side and 100th Anniversary on the other side. Terri seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Rhonda said that the 5k shirts have been ordered. She needs to find the bib numbers. She will contact Naturalist James Anderson about coming to the Bang from noon till 4 pm.

Cheryl just finished asking Ohio Health for sponsorship money. David Palmer sent the group \$250. Everyone who donated last year got a specific thank you and a request for a donation for this year.

The Bang goodie auction will be held in the old Library. A suggestion was made to also put the silent auction items in there also. Barb contacted Ben Higgins about the preliminary information about the auction. She also contacted volunteers to help with the auction. Bertha volunteered to help in the afternoon. Debi is replacing Linda for the morning shift.

Terri gave an update on the poker run. She asked that we put something in writing for the sponsor of the event that explains what the money will be used for. The group needs to gather items for the raffle basket at Coonies. Josh suggested that someone contact Wilson FB to see if they would donate a FB for the basket.

Jim Anderson donated some La Rue historic/collectors' items for the auction.

Bang posters were distributed to put up in town and surrounding areas.

Debi's church thought it would be nice if a senior day could be held at the modulars. The group discussed Richwoods center and their newsletter. United Way helps fund that center. Barb talked to a UW representative who told her that the grant cycle was open and that someone would reach out to her.

Josh asked the LCA for a donation for work out equipment for the FD. A list of requested equipment was circulated for review. Mark moved to donate \$2,000 to this request. Mary Ann seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Cheryl invited some of the Lingo family to come to the event and be in the parade. She is trying to find some of the family members.

The group discussed prize money for the ducks and cow plop. Duck prize winners = \$150/100/50. Cow Plop winners = \$300/100.

The next Bang meeting is on May 3rd at 6:30 pm at Coonies.

Ryan E. is to complete the electrical work when the weather gets better. It is unknown whether he has all of the parts or can get parts to do the work.

Council signed a contract for the 95 work and the \$40,000 in playground equipment. The group needs to talk to Access Engineering and Regional Planning to start planning the playground layout. Cheryl will email with Evelyn and Access to set up a timeline.
