The Community Block (CDBG) grant is due on July 14th. The grant requests \$40,000 for a community splash park. The Commissioners approved our request for this money.

This sketch should include the splash park, playground equipment, walkways, and gazebo/shelter house.

Connie suggested using part of the municipal building for a senior/civic center area.

Dustin signed the loan paperwork so that the water tower project can move forward.

Peggy is working on the quilt for the Oorang Bang. She will hang on to it for next year's event.
